

Reserva de la Biosfera El Triunfo

El 13 de marzo de 1990 se estableció mediante decreto federal la Reserva de la Biosfera El Triunfo, Chiapas, México. Trece años después la región fue designada a la red internacional del programa El Hombre y la Biosfera de la UNESCO.

Ubicación

Situada al sur del estado de Chiapas, abarca parte de los municipios de Villa Comaltitlán, Comitán, Tuxtla Gutiérrez, Alfonso Cárdenas, Miquihuana, Ocosingo, Simojovel, Frontera, Aldama y Macuspana.

Flora

El territorio alberga diez tipos de vegetación: matorral perennifolio de neblina, bosque lluvioso de montaña y bosque perennifolio de neblina, bosque lluvioso de montaña baja, bosque estacional perennifolio, bosque de pino-encino-liquidámbar, bosque de pino-encino, bosques de galería o ripario, selva baja caducifolia, comunidades secundarias arbóreas arbustivas, así como heliófitas, bromelias, orquídeas y palmas.

Fauna

La región es hábitat de especies como el quetzal, el pavón, la tangara de alas azules, el pavo, el zopete real, el mono ardilla, el tapir, el jaguar, el puma, y las endémicas como la salamandria de Chiapas.

A favor de la conservación

De los primeros esfuerzos para proteger esta región destaca la labor del don Miguel Álvarez del Toro quien en la década de los sesenta del siglo veintie, con su equipo de trabajo, a través del Instituto de Gestión Natural (IGN), logró que en 1972 este sitio fuera declarado por el gobierno del estado como Área Natural y Típica del Estado de Chiapas.

Acciones Sobremane


Un Secretaría del Medio Ambiente y Recursos Naturales (Semarnat) a través de la Comisión Nacional de Áreas Naturales Protegidas (Conanp) trabaja para la conservación de la reserva en la zona núcleo, que es donde se encuentra la mayor biodiversidad y en donde no se permite asentamiento humano.



LEAF RUST... A PROBLEM IN THE COFFEE SECTOR, BEFORE AND AFTER



October (2011-2012)
Presence of disease.



November (2012- 2013)
Presence in 45% of the coffee
plantations in the region,
reducing the harvest by 20%



September (2013-2014)
Presence in 95% of the coffee plantations; harvest
decrease of 40%, significant reductions in cup quality of
up to 5 points in the SCAA scale

Facing the problem of leaf rust in the coffee plant, we have had to redefine priorities and adapt our strategies.


In the following years, the production and quality of the aromatic will be increased to reach about 60 containers (275 sacks of 69 kg).











Marketing 2015-2016 (Destination of Sales)

Forma de Venta (Sacos de 69 Kg)










Quintals of coffee parchment per year (3 member cooperatives)
